## WRITING HISTORY - THE STORY OF "ANOTHER MOTHER'S SON"

In 2017 the film "Another Mother's Son" was released, telling the true story of Louisa Gould, a Jersey woman who sheltered a Russian slave worker during the Occupation. Gould, who had lost her own son earlier in the war, took the young man in and cared for him for almost two years, but became careless about security. She was betrayed, arrested and deported only days before the D-day landings closed sea traffic to the islands, but her actions saved the life of the young man she had come to see as her own.

The guest speaker at this event is the film's writer Jenny Lecoat, Gould's great niece, who was born in Jersey and has been writing professionally for twenty-five years.

As the Society's guest speaker she will talk about her reasons for wanting to bring this story to public attention, and the process of turning historical facts into a cinema feature film.
